

# BODY LIFE

## SMALL GROUPS

## **WESTGATE 201**

Westgate 201 is a six-week course that we provide to members that want to receive intensive discipleship training. Westgate 201 starts on each Sunday after Westgate 101. Typically, we will have a Westgate 101 meeting every quarter and then start a new round of Westgate 201 classes.

We encourage any Westgate 101 participants, as well as new Christians, to go through this course. Each participant receives a book produced by the ministry staff and the course covers the following: New life in Christ; the centrality of Christ in your life; the Gospel in your life; the book God breathed (how to read the Bible); prayer; and the church. This class meets Sunday mornings in the gym.

## **ADULT EDUCATION**

## MIDDLE SCHOOL MINISTRY (GRADES 7-9)

As part of the overall Youth Ministry, the purpose of the Middle School Ministry is to minister to 7th-9th grade students as they transition out of the Children's Ministry. We join the Youth Ministry in the mission of developing faithful, independent, and mature followers of Jesus through worship, community, and service, but at a level that is appropriate for middle schoolers. We focus our classes on building off the foundation that was laid during their years in the Children's Ministry – reinforcing the basics of Christianity, building a faith that will carry them into their adult lives, and encouraging them to share the love of Christ to those around them.

As with any student ministry, the Middle School Ministry is a collaborative effort with parents and volunteers. The best way to volunteer for this ministry is to provide support for major functions and/or join us for class to offer advice and insights. Really, being involved in the ministry in any way shows our students how valued they are as part of our congregation. We have many activities throughout the year – Up, In, & Out Spring Retreat, Encounter Fall Retreat, service projects – as well as camps and Impact during the summer.

## CARE MINISTRIES

### FOOD PANTRY
