- 3) The thorny soil is the type of heart that has competing interests crowding out one's love for Jesus. What are some common things people deal with that compete for our affection and limit the influence of Jesus in our lives?
- 4) In the sermon, Chris talked a good bit about deconstruction in faith. When can deconstruction help grow our faith and when can it be detrimental?
- 5) <u>Do say this out loud:</u> Take a minute to pray to Jesus to come into your heart and uproot all the things that get in the way of our devotion to Him.
